**School Board Code of Conduct 2017**

As a member of the Joondalup Primary School board, I will support students, teachers and the wider school community by providing responsible governance in accordance with the following standards and principles:

Preparation	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. I will prepare for, attend and actively participate in school board meetings.</li><li>2. I will model continuous learning by devoting time, thought and study to educational issues; by taking advantage of board member development opportunities; and I will encourage my fellow board members to do the same.</li><li>3. I will represent all sectors of the school community honestly and equally, based on the available facts and independent judgement, and refuse to surrender my responsibilities to interest groups.</li></ol>
Meetings	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>4. I will encourage systematic communication with students, staff and the wider community and work with the other board members to establish effective board policy decisions.</li><li>5. I will encourage the free expression of opinion by all board members and will participate in board discussions in an open and respectful manner, honouring differences of opinion or perspectives.</li></ol>
Afterwards	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>6. I will abide by majority decisions of the board, while retaining the right to seek changes in such decisions through ethical and constructive channels.</li><li>7. I will respectfully listen to expressions of public reaction to policies and procedures, seeking to understand the viewpoint and will maintain confidentiality and privacy.</li></ol>
Throughout	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>8. I will take no private action that might compromise the board or school and will respect the confidentiality of privileged information.</li><li>9. I will avoid any conflict of interest or the appearance of impropriety which could result from my position, and will not use my board membership for personal gain or publicity.</li><li>10. I will abide by all relevant legislation and industrial agreements.</li></ol>
